MAIN EXHIBIT VINCENT PRICE ART MUSEUM

WHAT The exhibit "Mis Papeles" will feature the work of emerging Los Angeles-based artist Lorenza Hurtado Segovia. Covering the local talent's compositions from 2007 to the present, the show will focus on Segovia's wonderfully weird explorations of different artistic mediums, from painting and sculpture to weaving and paper crafts.

WHERE You can visit the museum at 1301 Avenida Cesar Chavez in Monterey Park.

WHEN The show begins January 24 and will run through April 18.

WHO Segovia, who moved to Los Angeles from Mexico in 2009 to pursue a degree in the arts, explores the inherent tensions of immigrant and transnational experiences in his multimedia works.

WHY Because there's depth and complexity in the artist's subject matter, but he accomplishes it in a way that invites the viewer in as an active participant, with pieces that blur the boundaries between genres and can feel at times both childlike and incredibly dramatic.

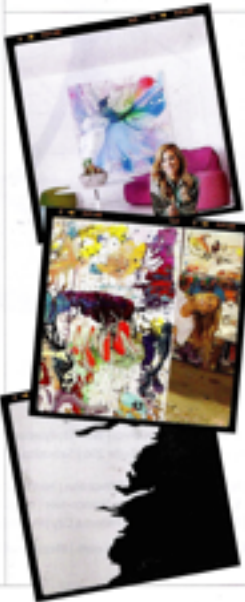
